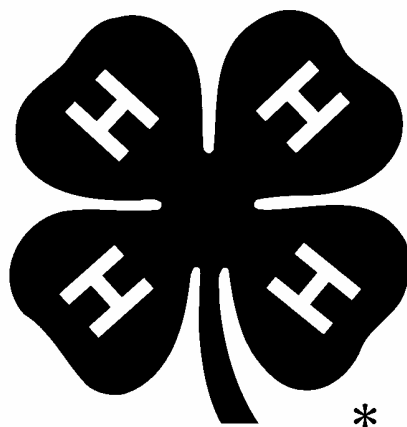

General Rules

Apply to all livestock shows unless otherwise indicated.

1. **All entries are due June 20, 2008 (postmarked) unless otherwise indicated.**
2. All exhibitors are required to abide by the "Showing Character in Livestock Projects" curriculum.
3. Upon arrival to the fairgrounds, animals will be checked for visible signs of disease and will be turned away by show officials if there is any sign of illness.
4. Scrapie tags will be used for identification and will be checked upon entry to the grounds and **BEFORE** animals are penned. Animals without correct identification will be sent home immediately. (Scrapie tags are mandatory and must be attached to the animal; unless the animal is registered with a tattoo corresponding to the information on their registration papers.)
5. All market entries will be sold at commercial market price and breeding class entries will be released at the end of their respective competitions and must be removed from the premises at the close of the Fair on the day of the competition.
6. All participants are expected to complete their own record books by Monday, September 29, 2008. Failure to do so will result in loss of any additional show and sale money. Judged books will be returned to participants in a timely manner.
7. 4-H attire is expected of all showmen. 4-H attire is a white shirt, dark pants, appropriate shoes, and optional green tie.
8. Showmanship participation is **MANDATORY** in all 4-H shows.
9. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. The show committee will handle any disagreements with judges **AFTER** the show.
10. The show committee reserves the right to further divide classes if deemed necessary.
11. Any exhibitor and/or project leader who are found by the Isle of Wight County 4-H Livestock Committee to be violating the above rules, or those that are specific to other Isle of Wight County 4-H Shows will be banned from participating in any Isle of Wight County 4-H Livestock events.
12. Isle of Wight Extension and the Isle of Wight County Fair will not be responsible for loss, damage or accident to any person, animal or property. By making an entry, the exhibitor agrees to abide by the rules of the show and to abide with any final decisions of the show committee.

Pen Decoration Guidelines

All livestock show participants are encouraged to decorate their animal pen. If you choose to decorate your animal pen please abide by the following guidelines. These guidelines will help ensure safety. **Guidelines:** 1. The decoration size must not be larger than 22 inches by 28 inches. (This is the size of a regular sheet of poster board.) 2. The decoration(s) must be able to hang from wire and self-contained. 3. Decorations must include a picture of the exhibitor, 4-H Club name and county/city, name of the animal(s), and a picture of at least one of the animals over which the exhibit will hang.

Market Lamb and Market Goat Costume Contests

1. All exhibitors are bound by the "General Rules" listed on page 4 as well as those below.
2. This show is open to 4-H/FFA members in the Southeast District who reached their 9th birthday, but not their 19th by September 30, 2008.
3. A Five-Eight Year Old Class will be offered. This class is open to youth not yet old enough to participate in the youth lamb and goat divisions. The child may **not** lead the animal in the show ring, but a parent/guardian may lead the animal and the child may accompany them.
4. Only ewe or wethered lambs are eligible for the show. Purebred, commercial, and crossbred lambs may be shown.
5. All lambs must be owned by, positively identified and in the possession and care of the youth exhibitor no later than June 20, 2008. Entry forms must be postmarked by June 20, 2008 and mailed to the Isle of Wight Cooperative Extension Office.
6. If the project animal will be housed anywhere other than property owned or managed by the exhibitor's family, permission must be requested and an approval form on file prior to June 20, 2008. Approval will only be granted in cases where it is impossible for the 4-Her to house their own project animal.
7. All entries are subject to on-farm inspections to verify entry information. All exhibitors agree to accommodate such inspections.
8. Each youth may exhibit two market lambs and one commercial ewe lamb. All market lambs exhibited must be sold for current market price to an agent appointed by the IoW Livestock Committee. Lambs shown as commercial ewe lambs and breeding ewes will not be sold.
9. All lambs will be weighed during the specified time at the show and classes will be divided into light, middle, and heavy weight market lambs. Classes may be further divided if deemed appropriate by show officials.
10. Any animal not reasonably controlled by the exhibitor will immediately be removed from the ring.

Market Lamb Show Classes:

Market Classes - Breeding class entries will be released at the end of their respective competitions and must be removed from the premises at the close of the Fair on the day of the competition.

1. Market Lamb - All market entries will be sold at commercial market price.
2. Commercial Ewe Lamb – Must have been born after January 1, 2008 and has not produced a lamb.
3. Breeding Ewe – Must be at least one year old or older and has produced a lamb.

1. All exhibitors are bound by the “General Rules” listed on page 4 as well as those below.
2. This show is open to 4-H/FFA members in the cities and counties of the Southeast District, who reached their 9th birthday, but not their 19th by September 30, 2008.
3. A Five-Eight Year Old Class will be offered. This class is open to youth not yet old enough to participate in the youth lamb and goat divisions. The child may **not** lead the animal in the show ring, but a parent/guardian may lead the animal and the child may accompany them.
4. A market goat may be a nanny or wether and includes purebred and crossbred animals. Market animals must be born after January 1, 2008 and must be dehorned, blunted, or wrapped.
5. All goats must be owned by, positively identified and in the possession and care of the youth exhibitor no later than June 20, 2008. Entry forms must be postmarked by June 20, 2008 and mailed to the Isle of Wight Cooperative Extension Office.
6. If the project animal will be housed anywhere other than property owned or managed by the exhibitor’s family, permission must be requested and an approval form on file prior to June 20, 2008. Approval will only be granted in cases where it is impossible for the 4-Her to house their own project animal.
7. All entries are subject to on-farm inspections to verify entry information. All exhibitors agree to accommodate such inspections.
8. Each youth may exhibit four goats with a limit of two per class. All market goats exhibited must be sold for current market price to an agent appointed by the IoW Livestock Committee.
9. Classes will be divided into light, middle, and heavy weight market goats after weighing in at the show. Classes may be further divided if deemed appropriate by show officials.
10. Any animal not reasonably controlled by the exhibitor will immediately be removed from the ring.

Market Goat Show Classes:

Market Classes - All market entries will be sold at commercial market price.

Breeding Animal Classes – Breeding class entries will be released at the end of their respective competitions and must be removed from the premises at the close of the Fair on the day of the competition.

(Animals entered as breeding animals may not be entered in market classes.)

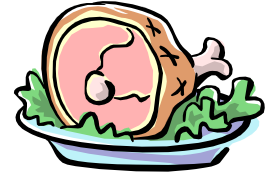

 10. Entry forms must be mailed to the Isle of Wight Extension Office and be postmarked by August 1, 2008.

4-H BROILER SHOW
Judging Date & Time: TBA
Entry Deadline: August 1, 2008

1. The Broiler Show is open to all 4-Hers from Isle of Wight County and adjacent Virginia counties and cities.
2. The only poultry eligible for the show include commercial birds supplied by the project leader at the beginning of the project.
3. Exhibitors may enter up to five (5) chickens – two (2) roasters and three (3) broilers.
4. Poultry to be shown must be on feed and separated from all other poultry. Pre-registration of entries must be received in the Extension Office by 5:00 p.m., June 20, 2008.
5. Poultry will be checked in on Thursday, September 18, 2008. All poultry must be weighed and culled prior to check-in.
6. Classes will be broken down by weight into roasters and broilers. Only poultry weighing 3 pounds or more will be eligible to show.
7. Record books are to be completed and turned in weigh in. Record books will be judged and returned in a timely manner.
8. Coops, feed containers, water containers, and feed will be furnished by the Fair during the week of the fair only.
9. Feed will be provided.
10. Poultry must be removed from their cages after 5 p.m., Sunday, September 21, 2008.
11. Cloverbud poultry class is open to bona fide 4-H cloverbuds (ages 5-8). This is a non-competitive class of market poultry. Cloverbuds may exhibit two chickens, any size.
